SUBJECT: Ground Strap on F-6158 Cartridge

The F-6158 Cartridge (General Electric No. VR II) has a ground strap which is an extension of the bottom cover of the cartridge. This ground strap is formed in such a way as to make contact with one of the cartridge terminals.

We have discovered that by removing this little strap, hum and noise pick-up in our phonographs is reduced. The strap may be easily removed by bending by hand.

We are now removing this strap before assembly into phonographs and recommend that the same be done in the field on replacement cartridges.
